MOSQUITO SAMPLING

Week of 4/20 - 4/26, 2014: 78 mosquito pools were submitted to the laboratory.

Laboratory Results:

- All samples tested **negative** for WNV.
- All samples tested **negative** for SLE.

HUMAN CASE DATA

No reported human cases for 2014

RESPONSE ACTIVITIES

No new information to report.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- To date, 204 samples have been submitted to the North Texas Regional laboratory in 2014; all samples tested negative for WNV and SLE.
- Dallas County reported its first positive West Nile mosquito test last week. The mosquito was trapped in Cedar Hill. No human cases of West Nile have been reported in Dallas County.
