**MOSQUITO SAMPLING – ALL POOLS ARE TESTED FOR WNV AND SLE.**

### **WEEK OF 8/19-8/23**

161 mosquito pools were submitted to the laboratory

### **LABORATORY RESULTS:**

- Two samples tested **positive** for WNV.
- All samples tested **negative** for SLE.

Location of positive samples: Grapevine

### **As of 8/23 –**

Total WNV positive samples: 15

Total samples tested: 2,691

**NOTE:** Samples tested by Grand Prairie (2) and Arlington (2) are included in the total positive samples

### **RESPONSE ACTIVITIES – UNINCORPORATED TARRANT COUNTY**

Based on sustained increase in mosquitoes that can carry WNV, Tarrant County conducted ground spraying in the area surrounding Creek Hollow Lane (Precinct 3, 76131) on Mon., Aug. 26. Spray map attached.

### **HUMAN CASE ACTIVITY**

A second human case of West Nile Virus was reported from the city of Keller. The case was in his 60's and was categorized as West Nile Neuroinvasive Disease (WNND).
