



## **INTRODUCTION OF COMBINATION BUILDING PERMITS**

Effective October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2015, construction projects for which a building permit is required and include any electrical, plumbing, or mechanical installations will all be issued under one **Combination Permit**. This permit will have one fee, which shall be paid for by the General Contractor as part of the issuance of the building permit. A fee breakdown by discipline may be provided upon request.

The revised permit requirements will eliminate the issuance of multiple permits for a single project. There are not any permit fee changes associated with the revised procedure so there should not be any financial impact to the General Contractor. The revised process will increase efficiency by issuing all required permits in advance.

All applications for combination permits must include the submittal of the M.E.P. Worksheet, which details the information associated with installations for electrical, plumbing, and/or mechanical systems. The fees are then calculated based on the worksheet information provided.

Applications received before 10/1/2015 are not subject to the revised requirements for Combination Permits.

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
