Total pounds of paper/corrugated shredded/recycled from the event—13,642 pounds (@ 7 tons)



Benefits of Recycling Shredded Paper

- One ton of recycled paper saves 9 barrels of oil and 54 million BTUs of energy
- One ton of recycled paper saves 60 pounds of pollutants from being released into the air
- One ton of recycled paper saves 7,000 gallons of water
- One ton of recycled paper saves 3 cubic yards of landfill space
- One ton of recycled paper saves 17 trees

The “green” impact on the environment based on utilizing Action Shred’s destruction and recycling service for April 9th, 2016 is:

63 barrels of oil saved
420 pounds of pollutants not released into the air
49,000 gallons of water saved
21 cubic yards of landfill space saved
119 trees saved
