Dear Mr. Kevin Ward,

Please be advised the total combined raw water supply in TRWD's western and eastern division reservoirs exceeded 95% of conservation storage on Tuesday, May 12, 2015. As a result and per the 2014 Water Conservation and Drought Contingency Plan, TRWD will terminate Stage 1, Water Watch, drought restrictions on Monday, May 18, 2015. Please remember to contact the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality within 5 days of ending the drought restrictions for your community by filling out the, "Public Water System Drought Contingency Plan Reporting Form," on their website.

The water district appreciates your cooperation with the enforcement of Stage 1 drought restrictions since they were most recently implemented in June 2013. Because of your assistance with drought and conservation program efforts, it is estimated that projected demands for all customers were reduced by 39% last year, saving an estimated 112 million gallons per day. These savings will continue to help ensure a reliable, regional water supply for our future.

Even though drought conditions have subsided today, TRWD encourages your customers to continue reducing waste by using water as efficiently as possible for an increased supply tomorrow. One of the best ways to do this is to promote the frequency of outdoor watering as twice per week or less and to turn off the sprinkler system if it has recently rained. Weekly watering advice for your customers can be found on the Lawn Whisperer Facebook page and it is updated every Monday.
