June Sales Tax Revenues up 10.77% over 2013

From the sales tax revenues reported this month, General Fund sales tax is up 10.77% (\$23,694) from revenues reported for the same time period last year. Year-to-date General Fund sales tax is up 6.32% (\$108,713). This is the third month of increased sales tax revenues as compared to the prior year, as March 2014 was the first month that sales tax was down since February 2013. This is the highest June sales tax allocation ever received.
