

Colleyville's annual patriotic celebration returns Friday, June 26, to the Colleyville Center. Award winning country artist Joe Nichols is scheduled to headline this year's event. Depending on how things progress as related to COVID-19, the musical talent may have to change. Regardless of the concert status, we will host a fireworks display that evening at approximately 9:30 p.m.!

Since his career took off, Joe Nichols has racked up six Number Ones and eight Top 10 hits, including chart-topping modern classics like "Brokenheartsville" and "Tequila Makes Her Clothes Fall Off." He's a three-time Grammy nominee, an ACM, Billboard, CMA, and CMT Award winner, and his last album offering, Crickets, kept the success going, sending both "Yeah" and "Sunny and 75" to Platinum-certified Number One status.

We are excited to announce this new service will continue moving forward, even after the Library reopens to the public, and continue to look for ways to serve our citizens.



Median and Rights-of-Way Beautification Project for SH26 on Track

As road construction winds down, medians along SH26 will soon receive a beautification update of diverse plants, trees, and hardscape elements. MESA, the City's design consultant for the SH26 Median Beautification Project, presented final design plans to Colleyville City Council in April. The project was bid in early May. The construction contract will be presented for approval at a City Council meeting in June with project completion in 2021.



The median beautification includes hardscape and landscape consisting of various stone elements and plantings of white gaura, black-eyed susan, lavender cotton, yellow yucca, catmint, Russian sage, fall aster, prostrate rosemary, Berkeley sedge, winter creeper, and creeping juniper. Parkway trees will include 8 -13 inch caliper Princeton American Elms and Cedar Elms. The landscaping design utilizes waterwise plants and will provide color and lush greenery year-round.

City Begins Seasonal Mosquito Monitoring

Colleyville staff has started its annual mosquito monitoring and testing across the city. The City tests samples of the mosquito population year-round but increases surveillance during mosquito season, which typically runs from April through October.

Crews place traps across the City to monitor mosquito breeding sites. Each week, City staff sends traps to Tarrant County Public Health for testing. The City will respond to positive mosquito sample sites depending on the results of the testing. Actions can include larvicide or spraying treatments.

Individual responsibility plays a major role in mosquito virus prevention. There are several practices residents should get in the habit of doing to protect themselves and others from possible illnesses. These include: using insect repellent containing DEET, picaridin, or oil of lemon eucalyptus, wearing long sleeves and pants outdoors, and draining standing water on your property.
