Glade Road Phase II Construction Underway

Glade Road Phase II construction, from Colleyville Boulevard (SH26) to Pool Road, began October 5. As with any construction project, we do anticipate inconveniences. Traffic will be one-way at times. Message boards will be utilized to notify the traveling public of the upcoming project and will be updated, as needed.

Major improvements through the corridor include:

- A roundabout at Riverwalk Drive
- Lowering Bluebonnet Drive while removing the stop signs for east/west-bound traffic; left turn lane will be added for eastbound traffic
- Strategic left turn lane pockets at certain locations to reduce the stacking of traffic
- Addition of curb and gutter and/or ribbon curbs with open channel ditches and drop inlets
- Realignment of the Bedford Road intersection to improve sight visibility
- Drainage improvements including the addition of an engineered Storm Drainage System
- Sidewalks and/or trails will be added throughout the corridor
- A crosswalk will be added near the Senior Center

Early Voting Begins October 13 at Colleyville Library

The Tarrant Council Elections Administration coordinates with the City of Colleyville to participate in the Vote Centers Program. This provides for the same 340 Tarrant County sites to be established as a Vote Center, making it easier for voters to find a place to vote by being consistent with the list of locations selected year after year. Vote Centers are intended to be used for all elections including primary, runoff, general, and special elections.

This year, voting will be conducted on the second floor of the Colleyville Library, for early and Election Day voting. An additional week has been added to the early voting schedule. All voters residing in Tarrant County may vote at any one of the 340 Tarrant County Vote Centers.

Eligible businesses can apply for up to \$1,000 in grant money to put toward an advertising campaign. Businesses who wish


to make a \$500 donation to an area non-profit will receive an additional \$1,000 in grant money. Advertisements must display the hashtag #ColleyvilleGives.

Special Saturday Collections for Leaf, Christmas Tree Recycling

Special leaf and tree recycling collection will return this winter. Community Waste Disposal (CWD), Colleyville's trash and recycling provider, will run special collection routes to recycle bagged leaves starting in November. The special collection days are Saturday, Nov. 21, Dec. 5, Dec. 19, and Jan. 2. CWD will also collect and recycle Christmas trees on the January special collection day. Residents are asked not to enclose the tree in a plastic sack or bag and to remove all tinsel, stands, and tree decorations. The collections begin at 10 a.m. to allow additional time for residents to rake and bag leaves and place the bags at the curb.



To participate, residents just need to set out leaves in paper lawn bags on the designated collection days. CWD will still collect leaves in plastic bags set out on regular garbage collection days but these will go to the landfill. If residents set out brown paper lawn bags for leaf recycling a few days early, CWD will leave them for the Saturday collections. Regular rear-load garbage trucks will be used for these special collection days. With that in mind, residents should be aware of and comply with their Homeowner Association's policies.
